Sue Anderson is intrigued and inspired by the beauty and vulnerability of the Australian natural landscape. Her artworks portray places of vitality and sanctuary, at times caught in the relentless advancing metropolis or showing signs of human interference.

Over the past 30 years Anderson has vividly described the Western plains and the relentless encroachment of Melbourne's suburbia into its delicate grassland habitat. Ancient rocky outcrops of Kakadu, coastal vegetation of Queensland and the windswept plains of the Monaro also feature in this exhibition of paintings, ceramics, drawings and lithographs.



Her unique visual language masterfully juxtaposes the patterns found in nature with geometric symbols depicting rooftops and roads. Like the bushland and coastlines she reveres, her paintings are alive, moving, evoking tension, joy and breathtaking moments of serenity.

Anderson continues to observe and explore her environment to better understand and portray the distinctive character of the changing Australian landscape.
