Fairlie Kingston's deep connection to the coastal environment resonates poignantly throughout her exhibition of recent works, *Lighthouses*. A passionate observer of the natural world, Kingston's distinctive work is alive, uplifting and highly evocative.

This recent series reflects the significant time Fairlie spent over the past year sailing through the coves and inlets of Sydney Harbour with brother and celebrated artist Peter Kingston on his beloved boat the *M.V. Anytime*. It was during these trips that Fairlie rediscovered her love of the majestic lighthouses that populate the harbour. This exhibition includes a stunning series of small scale illuminated 3D lighthouses in Kingston's highly original and engaging visual style. *Lighthouses* also features a beautiful series of ceramic reliefs which recreate the magical perspective of viewing the ocean through a porthole, as well as those reflecting the beauty and splendour of the ocean's surrounding landscape.

Fairlie Kingston's respect and understanding for both her medium and subject matter are palpable in each of her masterfully realised works. This enchanting series presents an inspired image of Australia's unique natural environment and our profound connection to it.
