Pam Tippett is a master of still life and portrait painting. *Here and There II* showcases the artist's deepening explorations into the relationships we have with the items that surround us. Tippett's remarkable technical skill allows her to create radiant, smooth surfaces without visible brushstrokes. Her highly distinctive works possess a glorious luminosity, rich colour palette and a satisfying simplicity of composition.

In this body of work, Tippett deftly recreates the intricate visual details as well as the profoundly engaging resonance of the objects that filled the studio of celebrated painter Margaret Olley. In complement to the objects belonging to Olley, Pam has painted an outstanding series of items from her own home, gathered over the years through world travels, local garage sales, friends, family and neighbours. A glazed ceramic vase, a chipped enamel milk jug or a simple arrangement of cumquats may resonate with the viewer as familiar, yet when presented through the perceptive eyes of the artist they become elevated; rich, vibrant and utterly entralling.
